A brief description of why it is important to you to exhibit your work at the Tychman Shapiro Gallery and how your work relates to this space.

Work Samples and List of Works

The following are acceptable work sample formats; you may submit no more than two of the following (please do not send originals):

- CD: label with your name, title of work, media

- 15-20 35mm slides or photographs: label each slide or photo with your name, title, medium, year, and dimensions
- Audio or Video: DVD or audio CDs, ten-minute maximum, cued to starting point, label with your name, title of work, length and year

Please include a numbered List of Works with title, medium, year and dimensions.

Return of Work Samples

If you want your work returned by mail, please provide a self-addressed, stamped envelope. You may also pick up work samples at the Sabes JCC when notified by the Gallery Director. If your work is accepted, your work samples become the property of the Tychman Shapiro Gallery.
